

Who needs First Aid Training?



By law employers have to provide first aid to employees and this includes people undertaking work experience or on training schemes. But don't forget, your extended duty of care to customers and visitors to your site.

Employers must appoint someone to take charge of first aid arrangements and you must provide "adequate and appropriate" equipment, facilities and people so your employees can be given first aid if they are injured or become ill at work,

These regulations apply to all workplaces including the self-employed or sole traders. As well as being adequately trained, first aiders should be fully competent and confident in their skills so they can handle urgent and possibly life-threatening situations.

Failure to comply with these guidelines or a disregard for the safety of your staff could result in substantial fines or even prosecution.

RLSS UK Life Support Award (Adult)

This award establishes an effective level of skill in Basic Life Support and in the diagnoses and treatment of choking, bleeding and shock. There is no minimum candidate age, and there are no prerequisites for this award. There is however a final assessment of skills.

RLSS UK Life Support 3 (Adult, Child & Baby)

This qualification establishes an excellent level of skill in Life Support for casualties of a lages and in the diagnoses and treatment of cessation of breathing, choking, bleeding and shock. There is no minimum candidate age, and there are no prerequisites for this award. There is however a final assessment of skills.
